Write a non-fiction story or put together a photo essay (photos with brief accompanying text) about a place in Nebraska. We leave the length and format to you – again, we're looking for quality, not quantity. If you haven't done so already, we recommend you read an issue of *Nebraska Life Magazine* before beginning this project.
